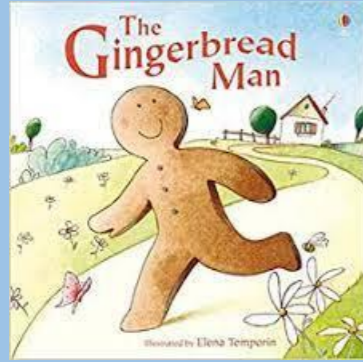


Autumn 1 - People

Literacy
