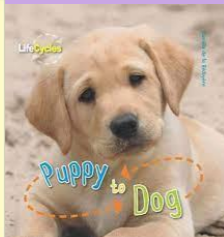

Literacy

During Phase One Phonics we will be thinking about alliteration.

As writers, we will write our names independently and make recognisable marks that we can talk about.

As readers, we will be learning new vocabulary and sequencing the events in a familiar story.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will learn to subitise (rapidly recognise amounts) 0-5.

We will learn how to name and describe basic 2d shapes.
