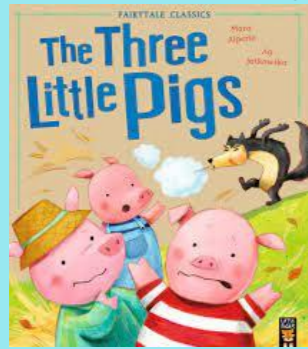


Summer 2 - Materials

Literacy

During Phase One Phonics we will learn how to orally segment and blend simple words.

As writers, we will make marks that we are confident to talk about.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will learn the concept of number from 0-5 and will learn how to represent numbers in different ways.

We will also learn how to create a simple AB pattern.
