## Key Stories

## Literacy

As writers, we will learn the sound that each letter makes and will be practising our letter formation.

As readers, we will be learning new vocabulary and sequencing the events in a familiar story. We will also be predicting next events and will be answering questions based on a familiar story.

## Maths

As mathematicians, we will learn the concept of number from 0-5 and will learn how to represent numbers in different ways and how to use these skills to make new numbers.

We will also learn about different patterns and how to continue and then create our own AB pattern.

## Physical Development

In P.E. this half term, we will be learning how to move in different ways that will help develop our strength and coordination. We will also learn the importance of moving safely around the room and not being too close to our friends when exercising.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

As friends, we will learn how to build relationships with our peers and will learn about the feelings of ourselves and others. We will learn how to share our toys and take turns with our friends to ensure that we are being our best selves and kind to everyone. We will have weekly celebrations to recognise success of all and will learn new songs about friendship and feelings. We will have time to reflect on our behaviours each week and will learn how to be our best selves.

## Communication and Language

This half term, we will learn new vocabulary that we can use to help build relationships. We will learn how to communicate appropriately with our friends and learn how to be a good friend to all.

## Understanding the World

As Theologians, we will learn about what we believe in and how this compares to others around us. As Historians, we will compare similarities and differences from when we were babies compared to now as a child. We will have a visit from a baby and have chance to ask questions. This will relate closely to our PSHE curriculum when focussing on family traditions and routines. As Scientists, we will learn about hygiene, healthy eating and how exercising helps our body. We will learn how to brush our teeth and have the Brush Bus team in to visit us. As Geographers, we will make observations of our local area on our school trip and will compare buildings around us. We will also become familiar with maps and how these look different through printed maps and aerial views.

## Expressive Arts and Design

As Artists, we will learn about different media used in art and be able to name these (paint, pencils, crayons, pastels, chalks etc.) We will learn about the artist Picasso and have the opportunity to look at some of his work (self-portraits). We will learn how to draw different facial features and then create a self-portrait using observational drawing skills.
