Literacy

As writers, we will learn the sequence of a journey story and will practise our letter formation when writing familiar words and phrases.

As readers, we will be learning new vocabulary and sequencing the events in a familiar story. We will also be predicting next events and will be answering questions.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will practise our counting through songs, nursery rhymes and rote counting.

We will learn about sorting mathematically, comparing groups, one more and one less and will look at time and pattern.

Physical Development

In P.E., we will develop fundamental skills and learn how to stay safe and moving around different spaces.

We will develop fine and gross motor skills through using different equipment and will learn how to work with a partner.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development –

As friends, we will learn about celebrating differences and discussing differences in our families and traditions compared to our friends. We will learn the importance of using kind words and how to complement each other. We will evaluate what we are good at and reflect upon how we treat other people around us. We will have time to share ideas with our friends and will work towards developing new skills to develop into our best selves.

Communication and Language

We will learn how to ask and answer simple questions and talk using full sentences. We will also learn new vocabulary and traditions from other cultures and the importance of respecting everyone as individuals.

Understanding the World

As Historians, we will learn about transport from the past and present. We will compare different types of transport and will visit Hull's Streetlife museum to capture the transition from a hobby horse to a penny farthing and then a modern bike. We will learn about Christopher Columbus and how he travelled around the world.

As Geographers, we will learn about the transport we can see in our local area, compared to those further afield. We will discuss the most suitable modes of transports for different journeys, depending on the destinations. We will then compare transport to different countries and how emergency service vehicles differ.

As Theologians, we will learn about why people celebrate Christmas and the importance of traditions in different religions.

Expressive Arts and Design

As Artists, we will learn how to collage with different materials and how best to join different materials together. We will work creatively on our own transport collage after looking at artist's work for inspiration.
