Eid Celebrations

We hope that the fasting period is going well for all of our families who are currently following Ramadan. As the Eid celebrations approach, please inform the school if your child will be taking a day from school to celebrate. This will be marked as a religious festival. Thank you every and a very Happy Eid to all.

COVID updates

The Government has again updated the COVID guidance—https://www.gov.uk/guidance/people-with-symptoms-of-a-respiratory-infection-including-covid-19. Many things in school will stay the same - enhanced cleaning, ventilation and good respiratory hygiene. Adelaide staff will continue to do all we can to keep infection low.

Main points parents need to be aware of from the new guidance are as follows:

- Children with mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough, who are otherwise well, can continue to attend their education setting.
- Children and young people who are unwell and have a **high temperature should stay at home** and can resume normal activities when they no longer have a high temperature and they are feeling well.
- As usual, if a child is too unwell to attend school, please contact the school office— 01482 223753—to report their absence.
- COVID testing is now no longer freely available. However, there may be occasions when
 a medical professional recommends COVID testing or when you choose to test.

 If a child tests positive for COVID, we ask that they do not attend school for 3 days.

 After 3 days, they can return if they do not have a high temperature.
- Adults and children who test positive for COVID are asked not to attend the school site during the infectious period.

If you are unsure about any of these details or if you would like help with a particular scenario for your family, please do not hesitate to contact the school. Thank you for your continuing support and for helping to protect our school community.

We hope that all of the children have a wonderful first day back at school tomorrow and continue to make excellent progress as they work on the Summer Term curriculum.
