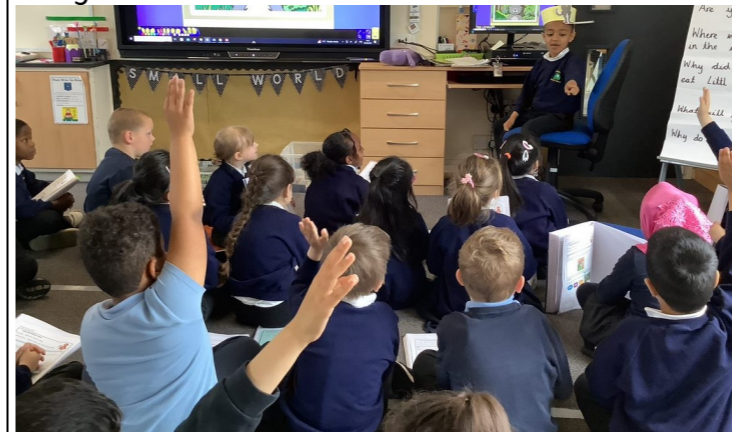
Year 4 Miss Thompson and Mr Snitch
