This is the first newsletter of the year so I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you back to Adelaide and to say that I am very much looking forward to seeing what the year ahead brings! The teachers have been working hard behind the scenes preparing classrooms and lessons for our new books and topics. Your children are going to have a wonderful time in their new classes!

School updates over the summer

- This summer holidays we have had several different building works being completed on the school site: The new FS1 building will be ready to welcome children next Monday morning.
- The FS2 classrooms have been refurbished with new toilets, flooring and an additional teaching space.
- Our changing rooms have been remodelled into 2 new spaces, one of which will be used to support our children that need additional support in an afternoon.

Attendance and the school day

The government have confirmed that schools need to be open for children for a minimum of 32.5 hours each week. At Adelaide this means are school day starts at 8.45am and finishes at 3.15pm. Children must be in class and ready to start registration by 8.45am. Cloakroom doors will be open from 8.40am each morning. Lateness and general attendance monitoring will continue to be a priority in the coming year.

Next week will see all parents being welcomed into school to meet your child's new class teacher and to see their classroom. These meetings will take place in the school hall initially and then move into individual classrooms. These meetings are very important and we hope you can make them:
