## <u>Packed lunches</u>




## <u>Sleep workshop</u>



Year 5 - Miss Thompson


Y5 Foxes have been working in Jigsaw to discuss what rights children should have. We have worked in teams to decide the responsibilities that come with having these rights.

#### Year 4 - Mrs Harvie


