The School Day

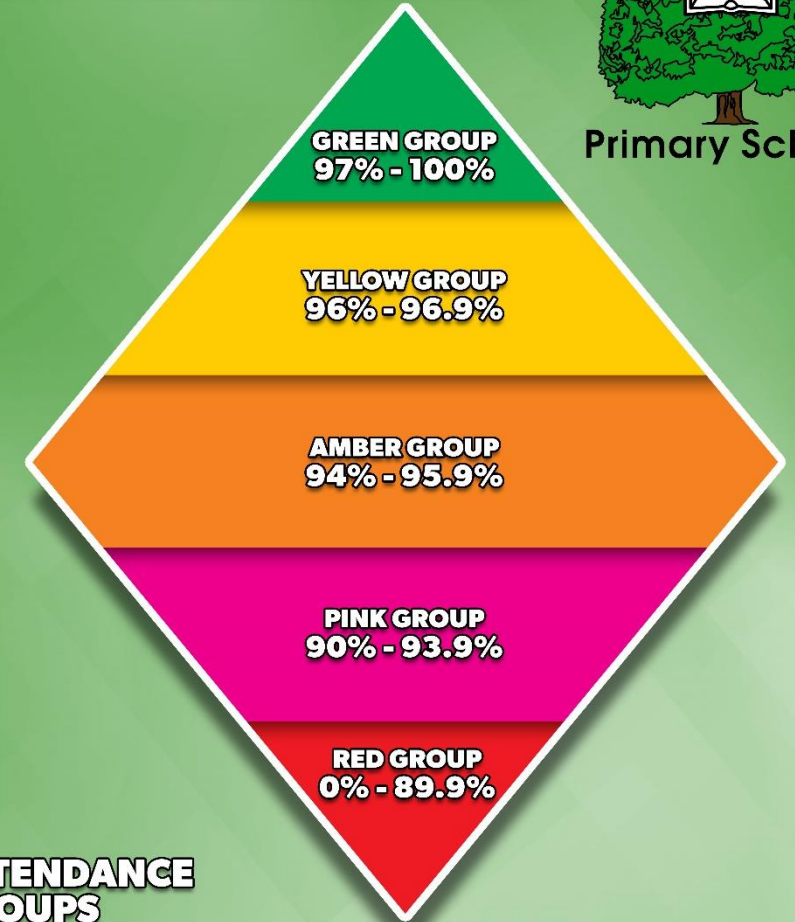
- Our school week is organised so that all children have access to 32.5 hours of learning time over the week

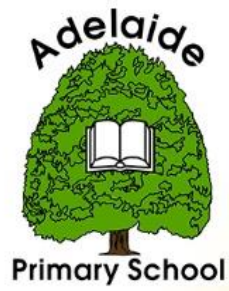

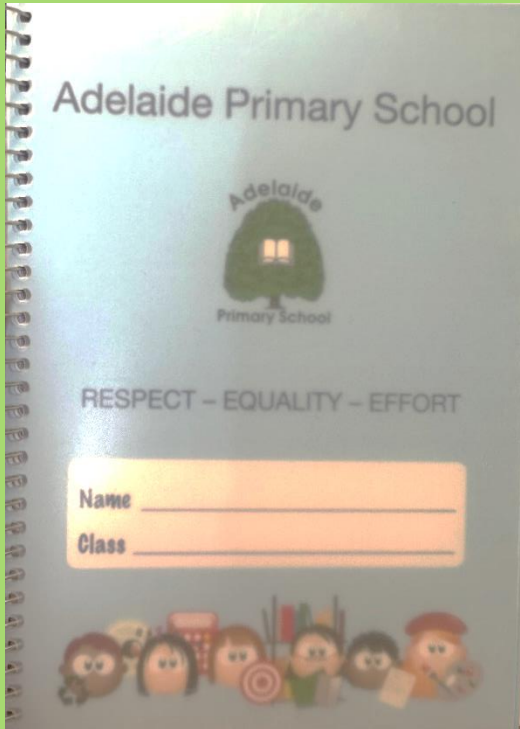



Reading at home

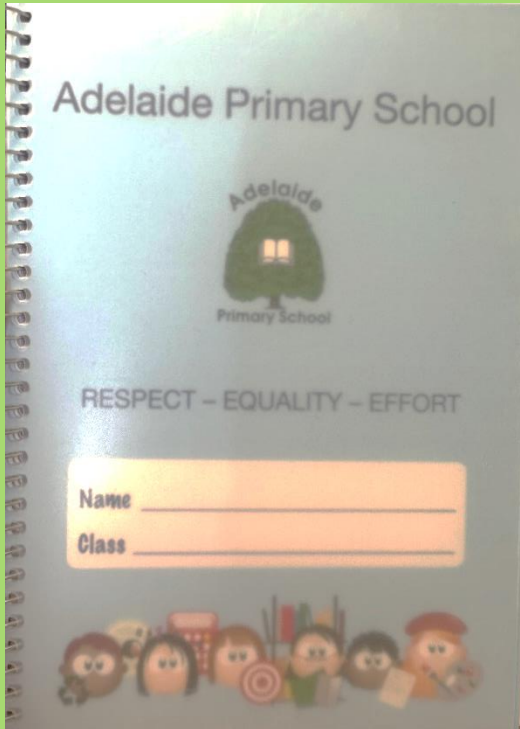

Autumn Term
2023

Anglo Saxons

Visits and Visitors

We will encounter the 'Sirius Science Experience' to learn all about forces.

History

Traveling back in time, we will learn about how people lived during the Anglo Saxon era

Science

This term we will learn all about forces, Earth and space.

Geography

We will be learning how to use maps, including using 6 figure grid references and the 8 points of the compass.

PE
