- At Adelaide we expect our children to take pride in their uniform.

The school uniform is:

- Black or grey skirt/trousers/pinafore
- White polo shirt
- Navy jumper or cardigan (branded or unbranded)

- NO make-up / studs only for jewellery





The School Day

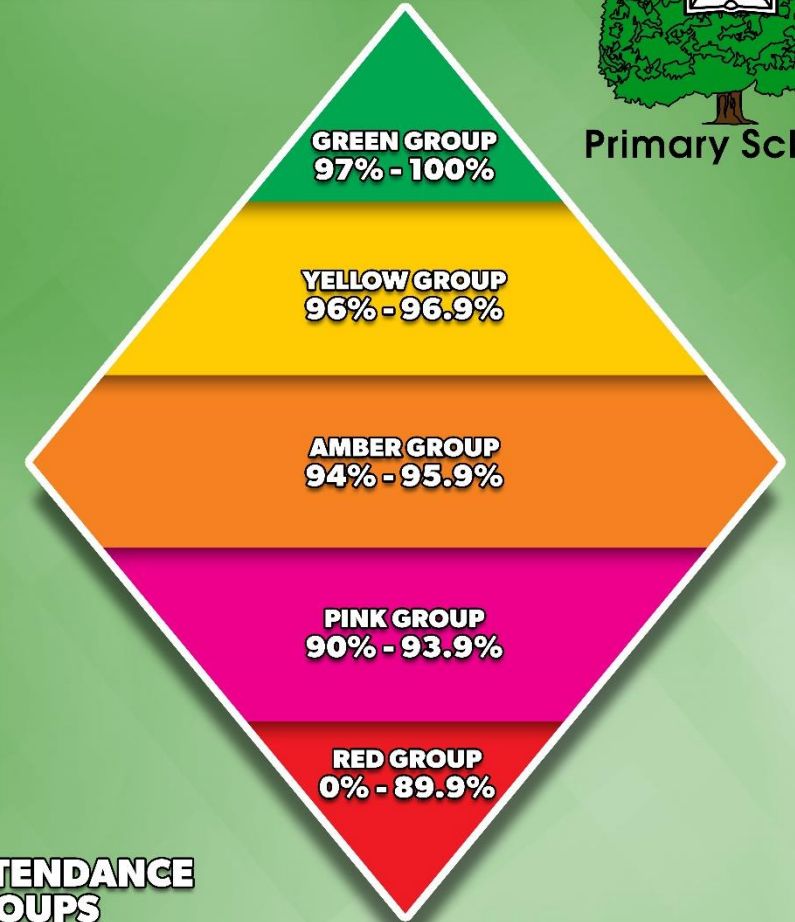
- Our school week is organised so that all children have access to 32.5 hours of learning time over the week

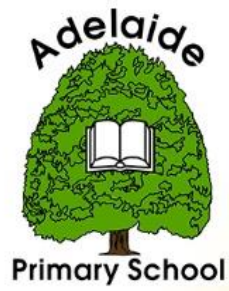

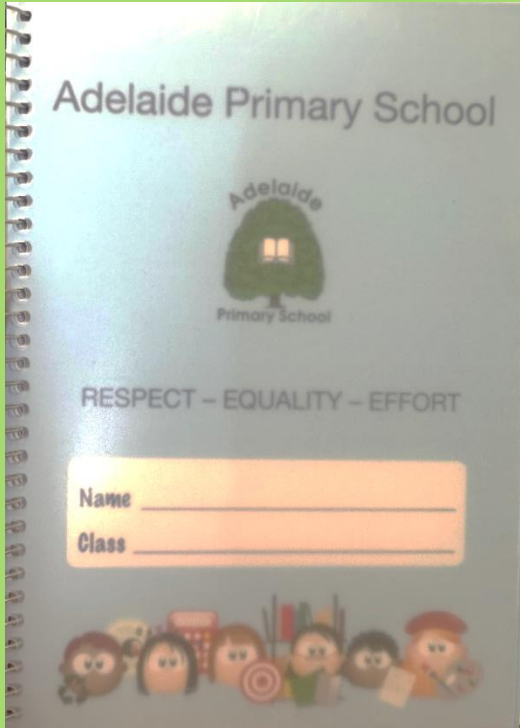



Reading at home

- **Supporting your child to be a fluent reader is one of the most important things you can do.**
- Children will be given a reading book to read at home each night.
- We ask that children read at least 5 times a week to practice their fluency.
- Please sign your child's reading record book each time they read at home.
- Reading record books will be checked at school each day and children will be rewarded.

- ✓ Please ask class teacher for support if children are struggling





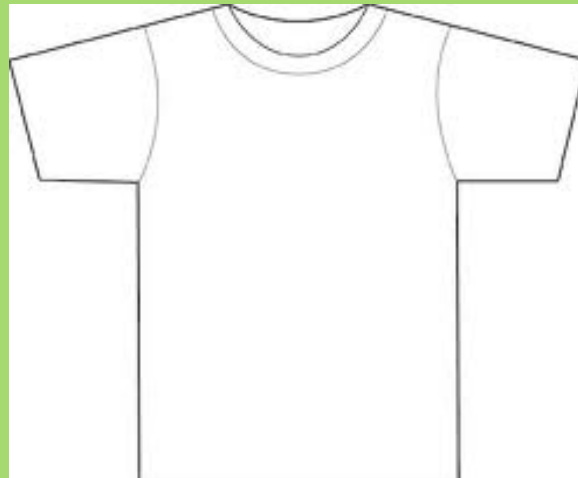

How can you help

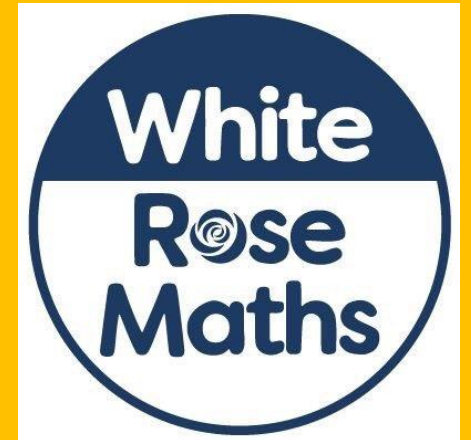
- Be at school **on time everyday**

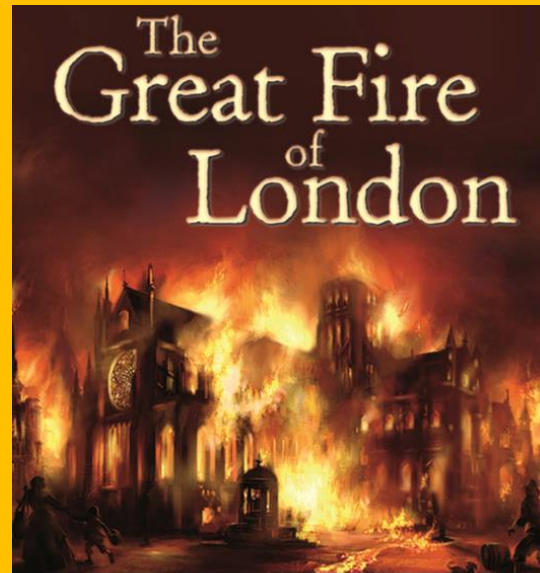
