The School Day

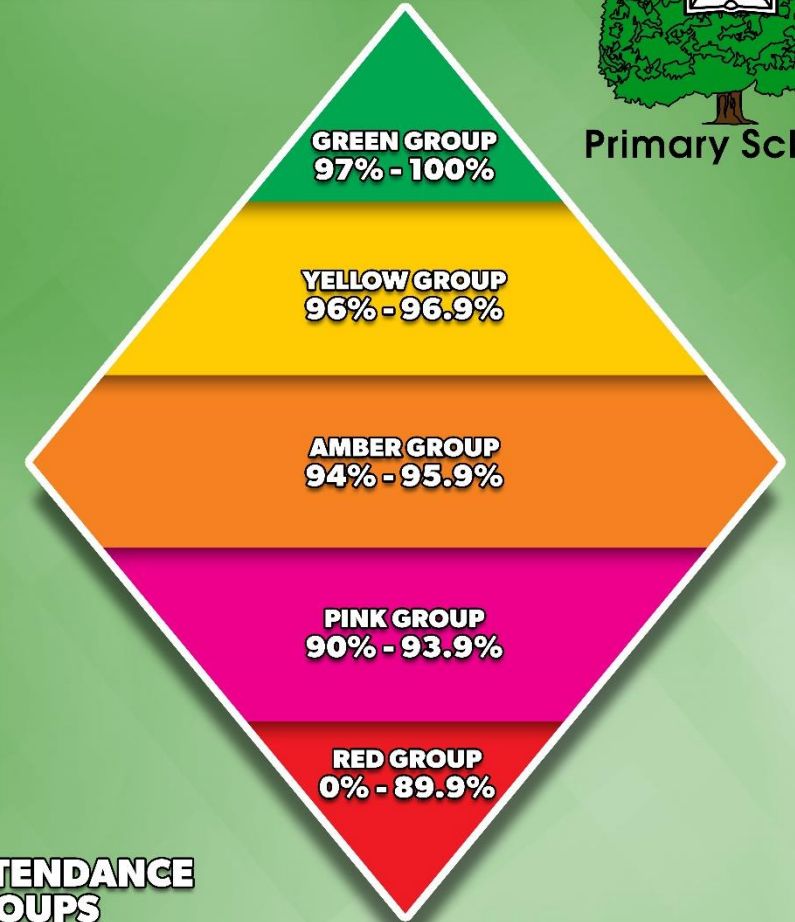
- Our school week is organised so that all children have access to 32.5 hours of learning time over the week

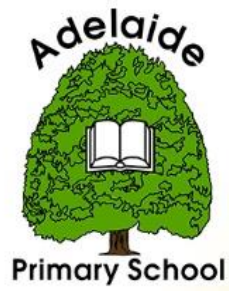

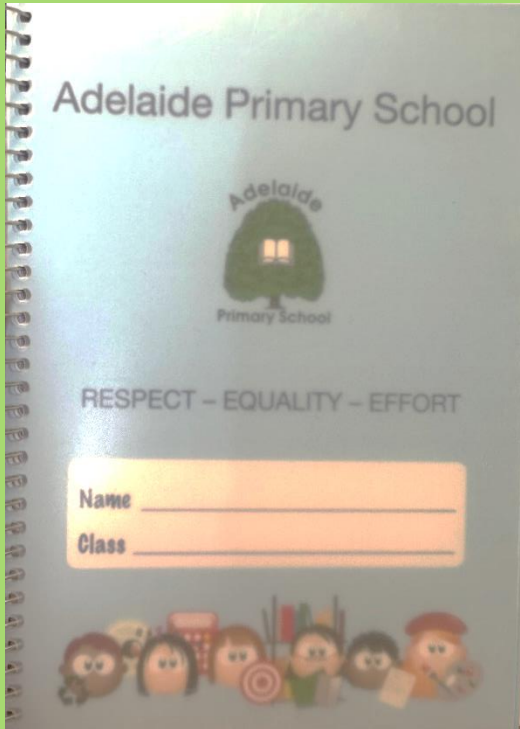



Reading at home

- ✓ Please ask class teacher for support if children are struggling

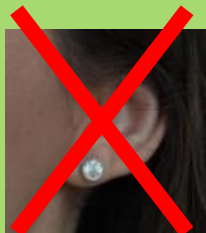

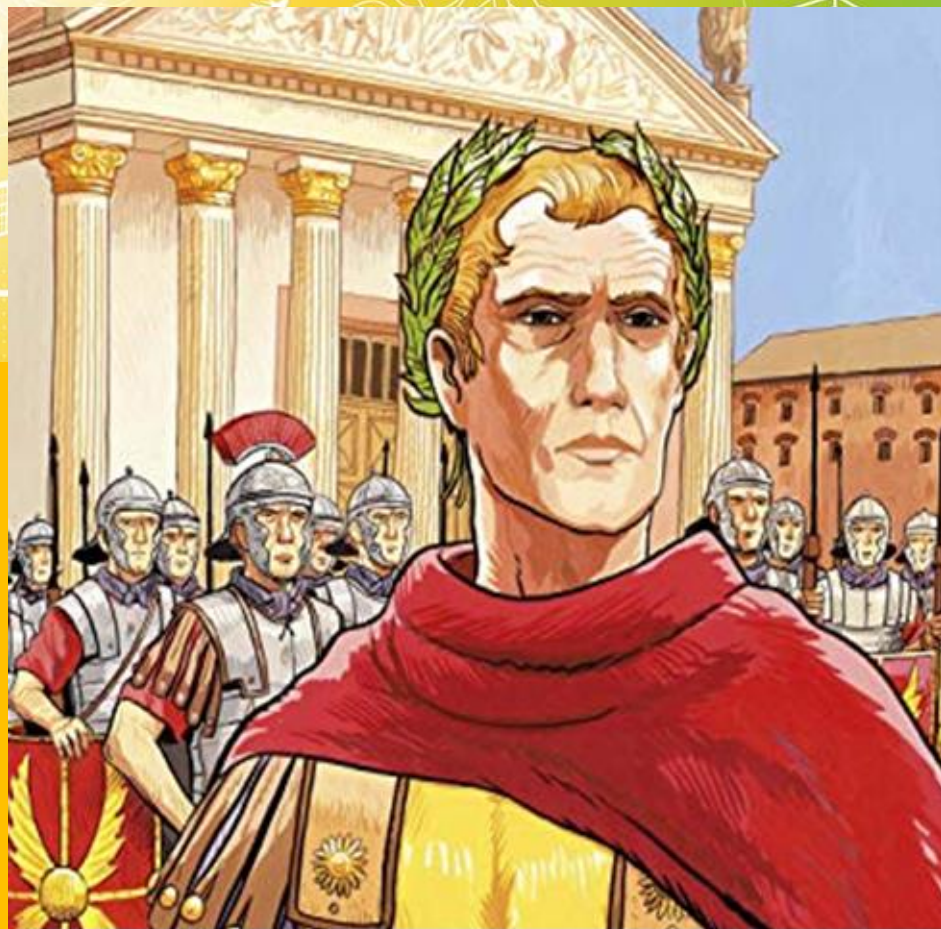
