
School uniform

The School Day


- Our school week is organised so that all children have access to 32.5 hours of learning time over the week


Attendance is monitored closely.
 Children have to be in school to learn!












Reading at home





Homework


- In Year 4, homework will be given out on a Friday and returned on a Friday.

Strictly no jewellery









PE


This term we will focus on football and gymnastics; playing matches and performing routines.
