We were so excited to watch the eggs hatch and observe how the chicks grow and change over time.








Year 1 - Mrs Shepherdson and Mrs Adkinson





Year 1 - Mrs Phillips


Year 2 - Mrs Turnery and Mrs Johnson




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Attendance Matters at Adelaide Primary School
