Staffing updates:

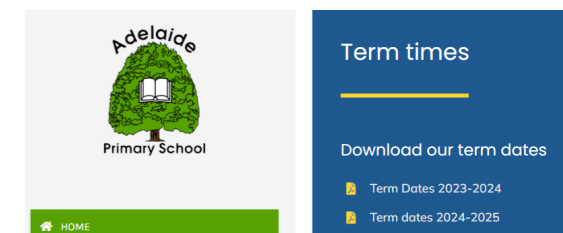
Mrs Louth (FS2 teacher) will be leaving us on Friday, to start new adventures over in Australia! We wish her all the very best.

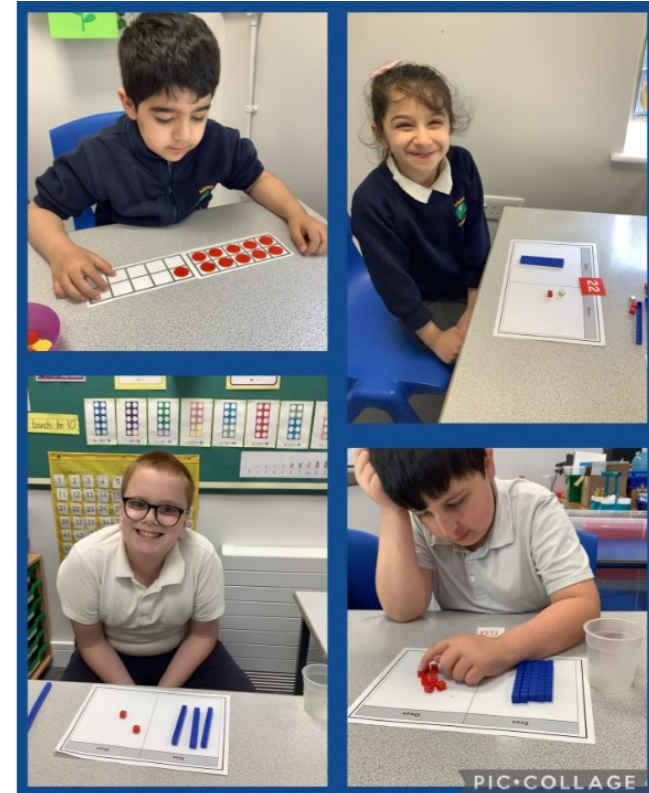
Year 2 - Miss Ball

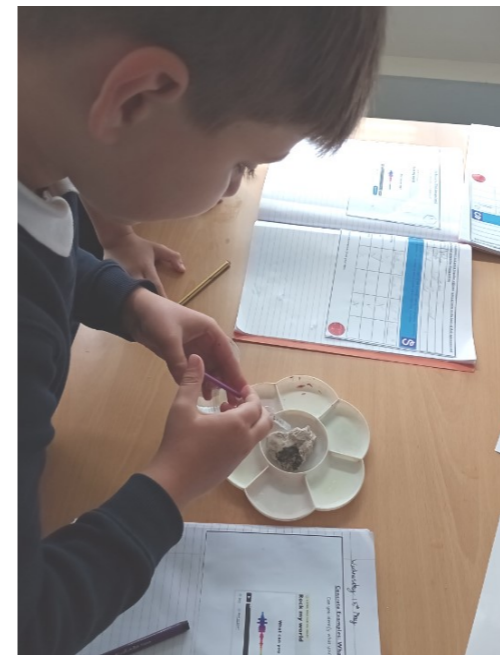
Year 3 - Miss Harrison

Year 3 - Miss Mangan

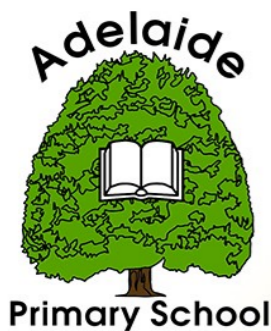
In Science, the Meerkats have been testing the properties of different rocks. We devised tests for durability, porosity and density. We showed excellent teamwork and perseverance.

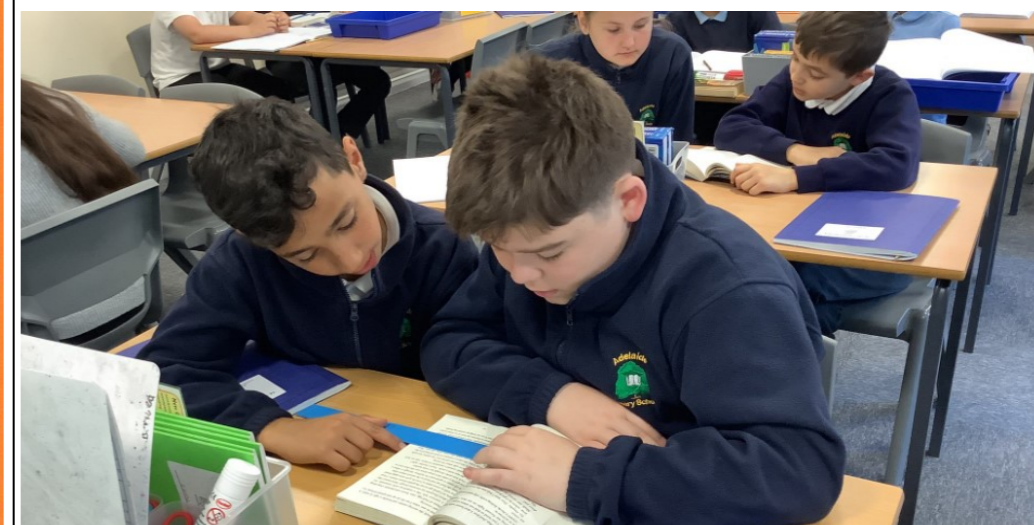
Year 6 - Miss Holmes

Year 6 have enjoyed visiting MKM stadium and learning all about the stadium. They were able to have a tour and explore the seats, pitch, training room and changing rooms.

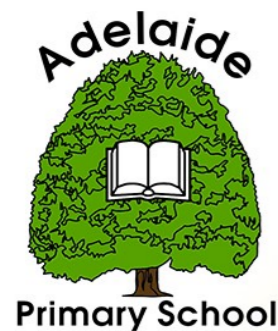


Year 6 - Mrs Turvey and Miss Anthony

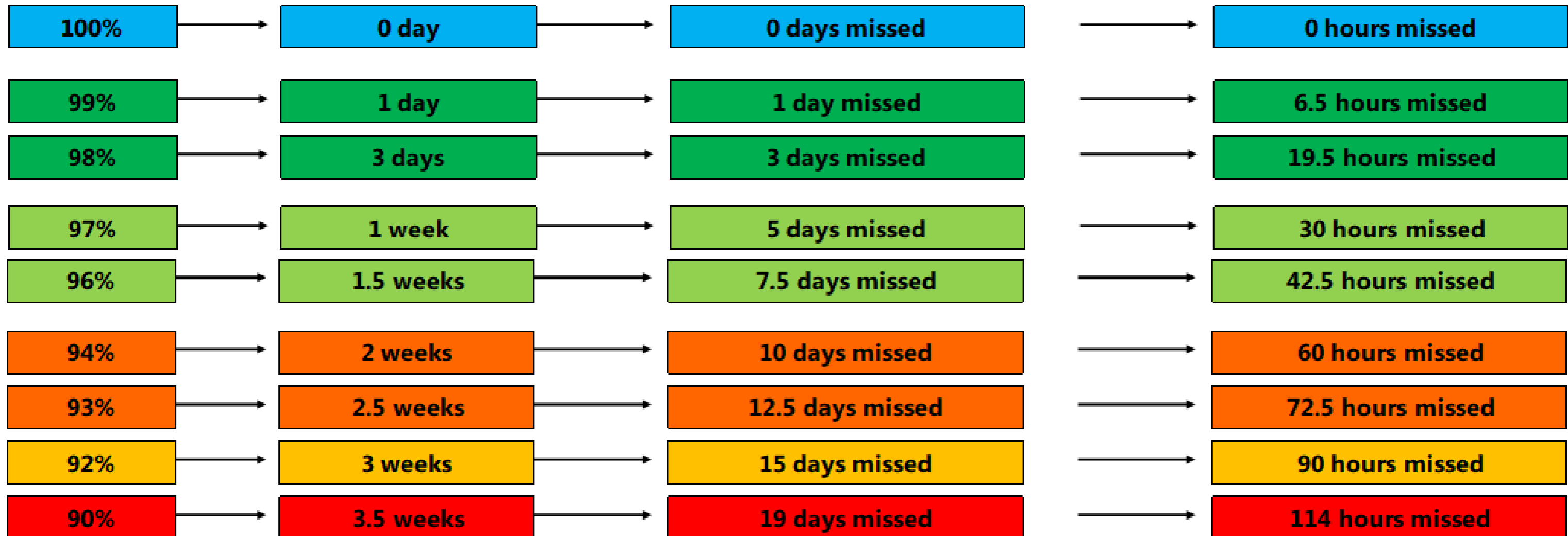
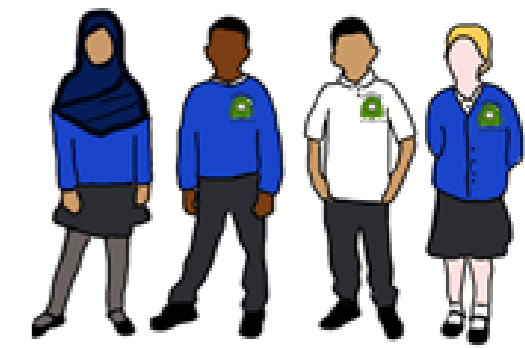
