Comic Relief RED NOSE Non-Uniform Day

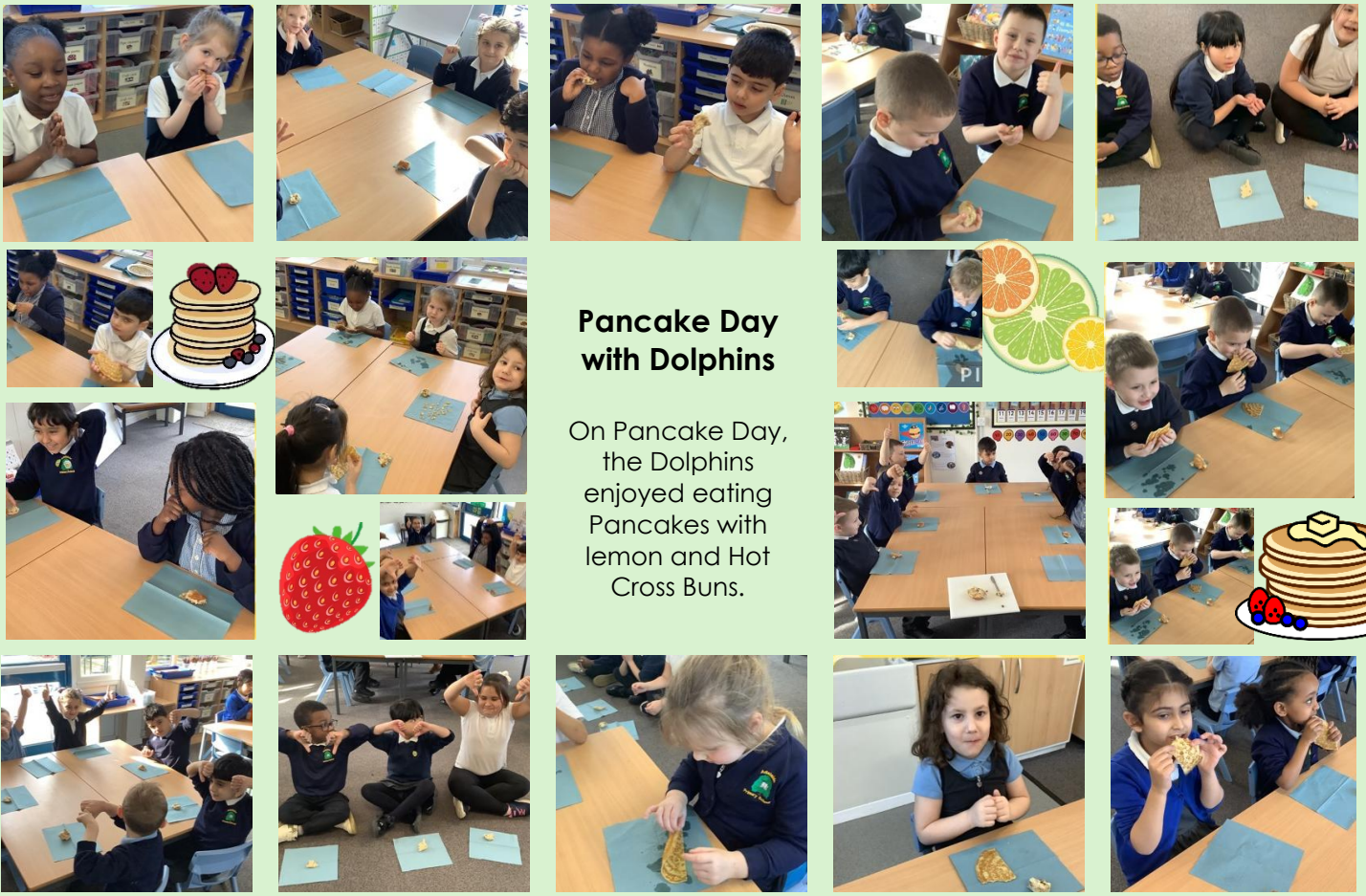
