Sun Safety

As the weather gets warmer, we kindly ask parents and carers to help us keep children safe in the sun during the school day.

Please consider the following:

- Hats: A wide-brimmed or peaked hat is encouraged to provide shade.
- Water Bottles: Staying hydrated is important. Please send your child with a reusable water bottle.
- Sunscreen: applied before school. You may also send in a labelled bottle of sunscreen if your child can reapply it themselves.
- Light Clothing: Children are encouraged to wear light, breathable clothing in line with the school uniform.
- Footwear: Comfortable, closed-toe shoes are best for active play (not crocs).

We will ensure children have access to shaded areas during outdoor play and that they take regular breaks to cool down and drink water.

Y4 Multiplications Check

A reminder that our Year 4 pupils will take part in the national Multiplication Tables Check in June 2025.

This is a short assessment designed to check their fluency with times tables up to 12x12. The children have been practicing regularly and we're confident they'll do brilliantly!

Y2 Phonics Screening

Also in June, our Year 2 pupils will take part in the Phonics Screening Check.

This is a short assessment to check how well children can use their phonics skills to read words. The children have been working hard and will do great!

Y6 PSHE: Changing Me Jigsaw Unit

During the second half of the Summer term your child will be completing the Changing Me Jigsaw unit with their class.

This unit is fully compliant with the statutory government relationships and health education guidance. There is no right for parents to withdraw children from relationships and health education lessons (including puberty) as they are statutory.

However, for children in Year 4-6, they are taught within the six-lesson unit, one lesson that is considered sex education. Whilst we strongly encourage all parents/carers to allow their children to participate in all lessons, there is a parental right of withdrawal from this one sex education lesson.

If you wish your child to be withdrawn from this one lesson, then you will need to inform the school in writing by the end of this half term: Friday 23rd May.
